Dear STM Parents and Students,

I hope you and your family are having a restful and refreshing summer vacation. The days are passing quickly and before long it will be time to return to St. Thomas More Catholic School for the 2011-12 school year.....**WELCOME BACK!** This year, and always, we will continue to strive to live our STM mission in all that we do: *"St. Thomas More Catholic School is committed to continuing a legacy of excellence in religious and academic education in a nurturing environment that fosters self discipline."* We remain dedicated to the great tradition of Catholic education. In partnership with our Church, parents and community, we foster an atmosphere that emphasizes high academic achievement, Catholic values and personal development and growth. We will continue to provide for a balance in all these areas. During the last week of school in May, our 8th grade class selected our prayer reflection for this school year: *"It is in giving of oneself that one receives"* (St. Francis of Assisi) This theme touches every component of the mission of STM and all that you do every day in your ministry of educating children.

The 2003 *"Preparing STM School for the Future Strategic Plan"* conducted by the 2002 STM School Board projected that by 2005 our student enrollment would be approximately 900 students due to shifting demographics in our area. Although this did not happen in 2005, we have noticed a gradual trend towards that projected student population. Our current school board and administration have been planning and preparing for this enrollment to ensure that the quality of our educational programs and opportunities offered for our students and parents continue the STM *Legacy of Excellence*. For the past two years our enrollment has remained between 880 – 900 students. Therefore, we will continue to create homeroom sections based upon the number of students enrolled in a particular grade. For example, last year we had five homeroom sections in 7th grade due to a large enrollment for that grade and this year 1st grade will have three sections due to a smaller number of students.

THANKS to all of your continued support, we reached 60% of our pledge goal to begin our campus new construction and renovations. It is our hope that the start of construction will begin this fall. I look forward to providing you with more details during Back-to-School Nights on August 16 (grades 5 – 8) and August 23 (grades K – 4).

Please join me in welcoming new teachers, and all returning teachers, to STM for next year. They spent several days on campus this summer working within departments and grade levels to plan cohesive instructional units based upon national standards, state frameworks, and best practices in teaching research.

- **Kristin Baldrige** is an alum and returns to STM as a 4th grade teacher. She is a graduate of LSU and is certified in grades 1 – 5.
- **Linda Smith** will be teaching 4th grade this year after teaching for eight years in Livingston Parish. She is a STM parent, graduate of LSU and certified in Elementary Education.
- **Erin Ferguson** will be returning to STM as a Kindergarten Assistant with Mrs. Lynch. She previously served as a teaching assistant at the STM Preschool.

We remain in great gratitude for your commitment and support of St. Thomas More Catholic School community. You are in our prayers every day and especially every Monday as we pray for you during Morning Assembly. I look forward to the coming school year and am committed to giving my best to you, to our Church, and to our school. We trust you will collaborate with us as we build on the great foundation of the past and look to a future filled with hope.

Enthusiastic Readers

The theme last school year for Accelerated Reader was **Read! Batteries Not Required**. During the 4th nine weeks, students in 3rd - 6th grades passed tests on 3,578 books and earned 18,486.2 points. The students had an average comprehension score of 90.8 for the 4th nine weeks. As a school, we are concentrating on improving our comprehension scores. AR recommends 90-100% comprehension for the maximum growth in reading.

We had 392 students participate in AR in 3rd - 6th grades. Our students read 450,085,870 words. Just think of the information and knowledge that went into their brains. We had 251 (64%) of the students earned 100 or more points. Of those earning 100 or more points, 87 (22%) of the students earned 200 points or more. STM recognized twelve students in the AR 500 Point Club including: **Joseph Alexander, Juliet Alise, Christopher Alumbaugh, Vivian Brown, Eloise Day, Sydney Hamilton, Reilly Helm, Jayme Kirkland, Audrey LeJeune, Jasmine Nguyen, Ethan Sledge and An Vu.**

Students passed quizzes on 14,914 books and earned 63,554.8 points.

STM's top reader, **Jasmine Nguyen**, fifth grader, earned 910.3 points. **Audrey Lejeune**, sixth grader, earned 893.6 points.

This summer STM offered two dates, June 22 and July 19, for summer reading testing to our 3rd-6th grade students of which 450 tests were taken. Summer reading is vital to maintain reading skills. The summer testing allows students who have completed a book to test prior to the start of school. For some children, this will decrease their stress of having to retain a large amount of information for the entire summer. If your schedule prohibited early testing, do not be concerned. Liturgy Choir - Fourth through eighth grade students are invited to participate in Liturgy Choir. The Liturgy Choir performs at All-School Masses and other special events, and members have the opportunity to serve as cantors. The group meets Thursday mornings in the church from 7:30 am - 8:10 am.

Liturgy Choir is an excellent learning opportunity for students interested in singing and performing. Most importantly, the choir helps lead worship. All students wishing to cantor need to participate in the group. Members should enjoy singing, working with others, and having fun.

Beginner Band - STM invites fourth through eighth grade students with no previous band experience to participate in the Beginner Band. The Beginner Band will meet after school in Mrs. Linder's room from 3:30 pm - 4:30 pm on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Members of the Band perform for school events and concerts throughout the year. Learning an instrument is hard work, but it is also a lot of fun! You do not need to have attended the instrument try-out meeting in order to be in Beginner Band. You must simply have a band instrument and a willingness to learn!

Advanced Band - Students with at least one year experience on their instrument are invited to be in the Advanced Band. The Advanced Band will meet before school in the gym on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 7:30 am - 8:10 am. The Advanced Band performs at many school events, including the Monday Night Football game, Open House, and the STM fair, to name a few.

Uniform Additions/Reminders

All students should be in compliance with the uniform guidelines the first day of school. For any student not meeting the uniform requirements on the first day of school, a letter will be sent home from the homeroom teacher. The following are reminders to the uniform code for the 2011-2012 school year.

School Mass Uniform:

- Girls – jumper, skirt, skort, or navy blue pants
- Boys – long pants

Due to the warmer temperature in August and September, boys will be allowed to wear shorts to Mass.

Uniform Length: The length of all girls' and boys' shorts and girls' skirts, skorts, and jumpers must be touching the knee.

Pants: The cut of the pants for girls and boys cannot be tapered in.

Tennis Shoes: Must be the traditional low quarter (low cut) style with shoe laces. Skateboard style shoes are not allowed. The laces must be traditionally tied. The majority of the shoe and laces must be predominately solid white, navy, gray or black. Shoes with characters, patterns, velcro, zippers, or wheels are not allowed. Please note: light blue has been removed and a shoe with any type of pattern (plaid, checker board, etc.) is not allowed.

Spirit Shirt: The Home and School Association will send an order form out in August.

Hair: Must be neat, clean and styled in a conventional manner. For boys, the hair must not extend to the top of the collar in the back, to the top of the ears or the eyebrows in the front, and the sideburns may not extend below mid-ear. Hair should not be slicked or moussed excessively. Hair may not be dyed, bleached, tinted or colored in any way. No hairpieces or hair extensions are allowed. St. Thomas More Catholic School does not recognize shaved heads, extreme crew cuts (where the scalp shows), asymmetrically or partially shaved heads, mohawks, wedges, or tails as conventional. No weight lines should be visible. These are examples and not a complete list of what may or may not be considered conventional.

Yearbook

Junior High students who are interested in working as Photographers will have the opportunity to register during the first week of school. No experience is necessary. For new Photographers, a portfolio of photos taken at school will be required. Instructions for submitting a portfolio will be provided. For portfolio work, students will need to use their own cameras. Either film or digital cameras may be used. Single use cameras are also acceptable.

Returning Photographers who will be in 8th grade will be contacted about working again this year. They will not be required to submit another portfolio.

Bell Schedule and Announcements

Our first bell rings at 8:20 am, students must be in line by the first bell. If they are not in line the student must report to the cafeteria for a tardy slip. Our afternoon announcements will begin at 3:20 pm. We will start dismissing our students immediately after announcements. Please make sure your child knows how he/she will be getting home. It may help to put it in their homework assignment pad the night before as a reminder. We do understand that changes do occur during the day and we relay that message to your child. Volunteering-Child Protection Requirements

We have been directed by our Diocesan office to ensure that all volunteers have the necessary paperwork to prove they have been through all the steps for child protection. The Safe Environment Program is mandated by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops. The program requires that we complete the following:

1. Completion of the "Catholic Diocese of Baton Rouge Application for Employees and Volunteers"
2. Background checks for all employees and for adult volunteers working in an ongoing, unsupervised role with children
3. Child Protection training for all employees and for adult volunteers working in an ongoing, unsupervised role with children
4. Signed acknowledgement for the Code of Ethics and the Diocese of Baton Rouge Internet and E-mail Policy

The Office of Child and Youth Protection is responsible for monitoring Diocesan-wide Safe Environment compliance. The Diocese and we at STM know that this paperwork, class, and background check is time consuming for us all. We are grateful that our volunteers are willing to go through this process to be with our children and teachers. If you volunteer through a Home and School committee or just hope to make a field trip during the year, please come by our office to get the necessary packet.

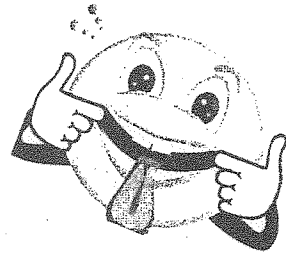

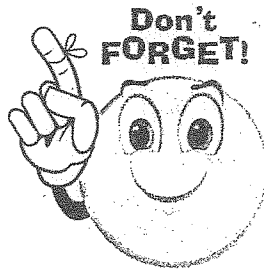
