### School's Angel Tree Service Project a Success

One of our school's largest, most involved service projects is the Angel Tree. Once again, our school community has partnered with the St. Thomas More Parish's Mother and Child Association in providing gifts for underserved members right here in our community. And, keeping with our school's tradition of serving others, we were able to make the holidays brighter for many children. To help bring the project to their level, and make it inclusive so that all students could participate, students were invited to adopt an "Angel." They were instructed to either purchase a requested gift, donate a gift card, or pray for those who benefit from the "Angel Tree."

According to Angel Tree coordinator, Monica Alley, the school's participation in the project this year netted 469 gift angels, 280 gift card angels, and 445 people prayed for - a total of 1,194 angels selected by our school students.

Members of the school's religion club, the CIA, took an active role in the project, too, by assisting in making the angels for the trees ahead of time, collecting and sorting the gifts, and helping to spread "Angel Tree" cheer in reminding students of deadlines for turning in their gifts and gift cards.

A very special "thank you" is extended to all of the volunteers who helped pull this project together to promote the mission of our school through service to others.

### Kindergarten Retreat

## Academic Education

### STM Wins Future City Regional Competition

A city of the future – “CASA” – engineered by students from St. Thomas More Catholic School has won the 2012 Louisiana Regional Future City competition, held at Southeastern University in Hammond. The eighth grade students – Vincent Bianca, Sam Lovretich, Stormi Verret and Amie Martinez (alternate) – teamed up with their teacher, Shirley Newman, and volunteer engineer mentor, Casey O’Quin, P.E., of Jacob’s Engineering, in Baton Rouge. The team will travel to Washington, DC to compete for the 2012 National Engineers Week Future City Competition™, February 17 – 22, to vie for the grand prize, a week at Space Camp.

Sponsored by the nation’s professional engineering community, Future City aims to stir interest in science, technology, math and engineering among young people. Students work in teams, under the guidance of a teacher and a volunteer engineer mentor, to design and build a city of tomorrow. They design future cities on a computer and then use a blueprint to build a model of a city section. They must also conduct research for an essay on a pressing social need. This year the essay centers on meeting energy needs and maintaining a healthy planet. The STM team created a future city called “Casa”, located in northwest Nicaragua, surrounded by steep hills and plateaus. The city’s mission is to promote a healthy lifestyle for its 170,000 residents and to maintain its infrastructure that keeps the city viable.

This is the thirteenth year for St. Thomas More Catholic School to win Regional’s, including competitions in Louisiana, Houston, Dallas, San Antonio, and Alabama. STM won the National competition in 2005 and 2007.

### Fifth Grade Students to visit Rosedown Plantation

STM’s 5th grade students will enjoy a special field trip to Rosedown Plantation and Gardens on February 8. This trip will coincide with their classroom study on the 13 Colonies and the differences in the North’s and South’s economy. Fifth graders have learned that, particularly in the South, plantations were built to supply income for families. During their trip to Rosedown, they will take a tour of the Big House, participate in a scavenger hunt in the gardens, and watch a black powder demo.

## Nurse's Notes

The "disease of the month" is: STOMACH VIRUS. Re-hydration is very important after such viruses. After vomiting, wait about an hour before trying to drink. Start slowly with sips of water and /or Gatorade. Start solids as they are tolerated. The BRAT (Bananas, Rice, Applesauce, Toast) diet is recommended at first. Please remember our school policy that children should be free of fever, vomiting, or other symptoms for 24 hours before returning to school. Even after vomiting has subsided, remember that the stomach lining remains sensitive. You may want to pack a bland lunch the first day that your child returns to school. Please discuss the importance of good hand washing with your children. Good hand washing can prevent most illnesses.

ATTENTION FIFTH GRADE PARENTS!!!!!! New laws have been passed that require EVERY SIXTH GRADE student to provide an updated shot record to attend school. Shots that are now REQUIRED for entry into sixth grade are the following: Tdap, the second dose of Varicella, and Meningococcal Vaccine (MCV-4). The shots can be given AFTER the eleventh birthday. The Varicella vaccine is not required if your child has had the chicken pox disease, but history of the disease must be noted on the shot record. Please make an appointment to get these vaccinations ASAP after the eleventh birthday, shot records will be due July 1, 2012. If your child does not turn eleven before the start of sixth grade, please notify me and make an appointment for soon after the birthday.
