Dear STM Parents and Students,

Thank you for choosing St. Thomas More Catholic School for the education of your child. Your attendance at our Back-to-School Nights demonstrated to us your commitment to sharing in this educational partnership. We realize that you receive a lot of information in a very short time during these nights. If you would like more details or just want to get to know your child's teacher better, please followup and schedule a conference.

We know that hurricane season is upon us, so, I want to remind everyone of school closure procedures. Should we close due to weather, we generally follow the East Baton Rouge Parish Public School System closures. Please listen to local radio and television stations for these announcements. We will update you through a call with our parent broadcast system, an email through your Edline account, and postings on the STM web site (www.stmbr.org).

Last week we practiced fire, tornado, and shelter in place safety drills. We do these monthly to ensure the continued safety of all students and faculty. Yesterday we ran an additional fire evacuation due to the smoke in the area. I sent an Edline email update to you providing a summary of this situation. If you did not receive that email, please take time now to activate your Edline account. We want to ensure that in any real emergency we are able to reach you through multiple avenues.

Thank you for your patience with carpool the first couple of weeks of school while we work on procedures and get a better understanding of just how many students will be using which carpool line on a regular basis. Your cooperation, especially with inclement weather, is critical to the safety of our children. Please do not ask your child to walk to meet you a few blocks from school to avoid carpool. Our first priority is to ensure that all children are safe. For the last few days, carpool has finished by 3:50 pm. If you arrive after carpool ends, your child will be kept safely with extended care in the cafeteria.

The bid process for the new facilities and renovations is coming to an end this week. I will send you updated information as soon as that is finalized.

Thank you for the faith you have in us, the faculty and staff. Be assured that each Monday we pray for you and your families at morning assembly. We remain in great gratitude for your commitment and support of St. Thomas More Catholic School community.

School-Wide Service Programs Kick Off with Military Collections

Our school-wide service program will begin this month with our collecting much needed items for the men and women serving in our armed forces overseas. Students are asked to bring items from the list below to be collected in their homerooms. Primarily, trial-sized toiletries are best for mailing. Don’t forget we have female soldiers too!

The items needed are: non-scented waterless hand sanitizer, toothpaste, tooth brushes, dental floss, mouthwash, shampoos and conditioners, chapstick, sun screen, lotions, bath soap, baby wipes, body wipes, eye drops, deodorant, foot powder, “Gold Bond” type anti-fungal powder, Lidocaine 4% cream, saline nasal spray, disposable razors, Ziplock bags of various sizes, and new or used paperback books (no romance novels, please). Students may also send pictures or letters of encouragement (no last names, please).

School Community Contributes Thousands of Hours in Service to Baton Rouge Community

“It is in giving of oneself that one receives” is the theme for the 2011-2012 school year. But, that idea of giving to others could have very well been used when talking about the amount and type of service our school community performed during the 2010-2011 school year.

In looking back over the past year, our school community contributed over 9,000 hours of service through a multitude of school-wide service projects! For our collections for the military personnel stationed overseas, over 60 boxes were shipped. During our Angel Tree project, hundreds of Christmas gifts were purchased and wrapped for those in need. Students raised over \$1570 to help the St. Vincent de Paul Society purchase prescriptions during our “Prescription Phil” campaign. For the Baton Rouge Food Bank, 62 pounds of breakfast food was donated to help feed children during the summer months.

These projects, along with the prayers lifted during the school’s “Adopt-a-Seminarian” month, fleece blankets for the homeless made by our sixth graders, special collections for Mission Day and the Parish Festival, are just some of the ways St. Thomas More School community members gave of themselves so that others may receive.

Of course, this doesn’t even include the multitude of hours our Junior Beta Club and Christians In Action Club members performed by visiting nursing homes, providing and serving meals at the St. Vincent de Paul shelter, and assisting with various parish-wide events.

While the 2010-2011 school year was extremely successful in the amount our school community was able to contribute, this is the norm and not the exception. Our community is known as a “giving” community and, in keeping with the school’s mission, will continue to offer our students and their families opportunities to share their gifts and talents through service throughout the community.

Nurse's Notes

The DISEASE OF THE MONTH is "church fainting." Several children feel "faint" at church each week. This can be due to blood pooling in the legs while standing or kneeling at church. Another possible cause is low blood sugar, if they did not eat a good breakfast. The best remedy is PREVENTION. Please make sure they eat a good breakfast containing protein before school. Encourage them to bend their knees when standing for long periods, and "bounce" to increase circulation to the legs. Although children appear very pale and "sick" when this happens, they usually recover completely in about 10-15 minutes. In healthy children, there is no need for alarm. However, if it occurs repeatedly or if they have underlying medical issues, they should see a physician.

Reminders: Please read the Parent/Student Handbook for all First Aid policies. Children are NOT allowed to bring any medication to school. If your child needs to take medication at school, please call Rochelle Bowman, RN at 272-3072 to discuss the necessary paperwork and limitations. Students have to be free of fever, vomiting, or other symptoms for 24 hours before returning to school. **Uniforms needed** in First Aid: girls' bloomer shorts, boys' youth medium uniform shirts, and belts of all sizes.

Health tip: For all of our students, especially our athletes, September is very HOT outside. Hydration is so important! Please encourage your children to hydrate the day BEFORE practice or a game, as well as the day of. Students are allowed to bring a water bottle to school to drink ON BREAKS or at RECESSES.

Transportation Reminders

Extended care drop-off is between 6:45 am and 7:55 am. Students in grades 2-8 will be dropped at the sidewalk to the cafeteria in the Activity Center driveway. Students in grades K-1 will be dropped off in the Preschool driveway. After 7:55 am, Extended Care students must be dropped off in regular carpool.

Carpool:

Thanks to everyone for being patient as students and parents get use to carpool.

For the safety of our children, they may not be retrieved from the carpool area where the students are waiting to be picked up. Parents must drive through the carpool line.

K-2 Carpool:

1. All cars should be lining up on Parkwood for arrival and dismissal.
2. In the morning, please do not use the driveways along Sherbrook to turn around. We all need to exit passing the preschool out to Sylvan. If your child disembarks quicker than those in front of you, please be patient and do not pull around the vehicles in front of you. It is safer if the entire group of cars can move off together.
3. Please do not drop-off your children prior to a duty teacher being present.
4. In afternoon carpool, you need a sign with the last name written in **large legible** letters. When turning the corner near the overhang at the end of the walkway in front of the Junior High, put your sign outside the driver's window for the caller to see. This will give children time to get to the right pole to be picked up. Please do not stop the line, keep going to the color pole called for your pick-up.

Cafeteria Reminder

Meal payments are due in advance--the beginning of each month or semester. Charging of meals is not permitted. A monthly payment schedule is posted on the school website. September meal prices are: **Breakfast:** Full - \$30.45, Reduced - \$6.30; **Lunch:** Full - \$53.55, Reduced - \$8.40; **Kindergarten Snack:** \$12.60

We accept payment by check or cash at the school. Checks should include your child's name on the memo line. Cash payments should be in a sealed envelope marked with your child's name. Meal payments are collected in the classroom by the teacher or you may bring your payment to the cafeteria office. You also have the option to pay online through www.schoolfiles.com. The school website has a link to schoolfiles. You will need an access code to set up a schoolfiles account. For your child's code please call Karen Long at 275-4347.

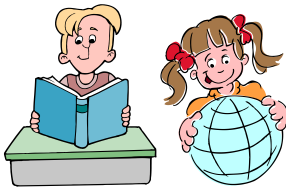
